



Sunrise Recreation and Park District 2012 Aquatics Certification and Training Programs

Registration for all 2012 Spring Water Safety Classes will begin on December 1, 2011.

Basic Water Rescue (Ages 14+ years)

This American Red Cross course provides students with the information and skills necessary to prevent, recognize and respond to aquatic emergencies. Students must bring a swimsuit and towel to class.

Lifeguard Training (Ages 15+ years)

This course is a combination of Lifeguard Training, CPR/AED for Lifeguards and First Aid for Public Safety Personnel. This course provides all certifications necessary to obtain employment as a Lifeguard in the State of California. Participants must be at least 15 years of age and have good swimming skills to register for this class. All Lifeguard Training Classes are \$200 and includes American Red Cross materials/certification card fees. There is a \$10 Pocket Mask material fee due at the first class meeting.

Aquatic Aide Training Class (Ages 15+ years)

This class is for individuals who wish to assist swim instructors in conducting swimming lessons. Students will receive training in the American Red Cross's Child CPR, Basic Water Rescue and Water Safety Aide courses. Also, students will receive hands on training working with children during our District swimming lessons. Successful completion of this course is recommended for summer employment as a Lifeguard/Aquatics Aide with SRPD. In order to apply for a District's Lifeguard/Aquatics Aide position, applicants must be at least 15 years of age.

Water Safety Instructor (Ages 16+ years)

The Water Safety Instructor (WSI) course is designed to train individuals to teach infant, child and adult courses from the American Red Cross Swimming and Water Safety program. The WSI course develops an understanding of how to use course materials, develop lesson plans, conduct training sessions and evaluate participant's progress. Upon successful completion of the course, participants will receive American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor certification. NOTE: This course does not teach lifeguard training skills or certify an individual as a lifeguard.

Jr. Lifeguard Class (Ages 11-14 years)

Participants will be introduced to the skills needed for entry to the American Red Cross Lifeguarding course, communication and decision-making skills and the basic responsibilities of a lifeguard. This is a one-week class that includes daily instruction, skills practice, snack and free swimming time. After completion of the class, participants have the opportunity to volunteer and become honorary members of the Sunrise Aquatics Staff.
