### Background

The Stock Ranch Nature Preserve is a 47-acre open-space park with over 1.5 miles of walking paths along the Arcade and San Juan creeks. In 2011, the California Department of Parks and Recreation awarded a grant to the City to promote nature education. The grant will be used to add educational components to the existing Stock Ranch Nature Preserve that help create outdoor learning opportunities for people of all ages, abilities, and incomes.

### The grant includes funding for:

- Water efficient Native Landscape Demonstration
- Oak Woodland Habitat Restoration Demonstration
- Interactive Interpretative Exhibit and Educational Signage
- Bird-watching Station
- Other supporting features such as lighting and benches
