Sunrise Recreation and Park District Awarded \$3.6 M for Arcade Creek Park Preserve
Funds from Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Program

Sacramento., CA. - Sunrise Recreation and Park District was awarded \$3,601,100 for implementation of the Arcade Creek Park Preserve Master Plan from the Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Program (known as the Statewide Park Development Program).

The Arcade Creek Park Preserve was one of 64 recipients selected for funding from a pool of over 400 applications. In total, \$368 million was awarded for the creation of new parks and recreation facilities in critically underserved communities throughout California.

When the Park District acquired Arcade Creek property in 2004, the surrounding neighborhood was considered an underserved area for neighborhood parks within the District. The nine acre preserve includes the meandering Arcade Creek and natural woodland landscape. Arcade Creek Park Preserve's Master Plan was approved in 2008 and incorporates ideas from an intensive community outreach process. The Plan includes a trail system, children's adventure play area, workout station par-course, a shaded picnic area, pathway seating, and an interpretive walk.

Arcade Creek Park Preserve is located within the City of Citrus Heights, on the north edge of the Sunrise Marketplace shopping district. The Preserve has street frontage on Sunrise Boulevard on its east side, and the neighborhood immediately around the Preserve is high density residential.

About the Statewide Park Program

The Statewide Park Program is a competitive grant program created under the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84), and Assembly Bill 31 (De Leon) in 2008.
